WHMIS Training

WHMIS training is required for all Status Sites and expires after three years. We offer an internal training program however external/ third party training is always recommended for new applicants

E

Occupational First Aid Training

While Status typically is not a general contractor and therefore does not require first aid services. On occasion Status require a first aid attendant for special projects where we are the General Contractor.

Mobile Equipment Training (Aerial & Fork Lift)

Status uses a variety of equipment to complete each project. Only individuals trained and certified in the use of mobile equipment are permitted to use aerial lifts, fork lifts, boom lifts, etc.... Using equipment without certification is a serious Safety Violation.

E

Electrical Safety Training System / Arc Flash Awareness

Electrical Safety is a top priority at Status. Arc Flash and Electric Shock incidents can be serious and life threatening. It is recommended that each applicant have a sound knowledge of electrical safety and arc flash awareness.

Fall Protection Training

Status is committed to protecting its staff from falls at heights. We offer a comprehensive Fall Protection Program. However it is recommended that each applicant have a good knowledge of Fall Arrest and Restraint systems.
